

**INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: COREY PAVIN**  
**Saturday, June 8, 2013**



**Q. 6-under, but a hole-in-one.**

**COREY PAVIN:** You want to talk about 8? I don't remember, what happened on 8?

**Q. You know what, there's no video of it, I understand. Golf Channel didn't get it, no local stations out there, so you're going to have to paint the picture.**

**COREY PAVIN:** I've got the video in my head. I got up there and just hit a 6-iron right at it actually. I hit a really good shot and actually when it was in the air I said, "Go in," and it landed on the front fringe or right on the fringe on the green and just trickled and rolled in like a putt.

**Q. I didn't think golf balls listened to golfers. They never listen to me.**

**COREY PAVIN:** Well, if you just keep talking to it, it's going to listen just by chance, I think. It was nice, it was fun. It's been a while since I made one. I think -- I don't know, do you know when it was? It was Kemper on No. 10. Not Kemper, Congressional on No. 10 maybe, '06 or something like that. So it's been a while, but it's always fun, it's always enjoyable.

**Q. That got you to 6-under and that's where you finished, 6-under. Just talk a little bit about the round. It looked like you had some momentum there after 8.**

**COREY PAVIN:** I played well today. I hit it nicely today. I hit a couple bad shots that cost me a bogey, but I had a lot of opportunities at birdie and didn't make any coming in, but I had some chances and some good putts and that's the way it is.

**Q. What about tomorrow now? You're in position. Good day tomorrow, weather depending, there's a lot that could go into this.**

**COREY PAVIN:** Yeah, I'll probably need a great day tomorrow, but there's a long way to go today. I think the guys will probably shoot some good scores. It's perfectly calm and sunny and the greens are receptive, so I'm sure someone's going to shoot a pretty good score today.
