

INTERVIEW TRANSCRIPT: BART BRYANT
Friday, November 1, 2013



PHIL STAMBAUGH: Bart Bryant, you got in at 8-under, right in the thick of it going into the weekend. A few thoughts about your round today.

BART BRYANT: It was a good round. I was happy, you know. I think 5-under was a really solid round out there today. Scores aren't quite as low as they were yesterday, I'm not sure why. There's maybe just a hint more breeze. That kind of moved me up solidly into position where if I play well on the weekend I might have a chance depending on what the other guys do. But I'm very pleased with the round, just solid. I did everything pretty well. I did miss one putt, I three-putted, but other than that it was an awfully good round.

PHIL STAMBAUGH: Any highlights, any long putts or anything?

BART BRYANT: No, not really, I didn't. When I had wedges in my hand, I wedged it close and made them. I got it up and down on No. 9 out of a bunker, made about a 10- or 11-foot putt there. Then on No. 11 I hit it close, and on No. 12 I hit it to about a foot, so birdieing 11 and 12 is a big bonus on this course.

Q. In addition to the breeze that might have been a little bit stronger than yesterday, what about the course, were the greens any firmer?

BART BRYANT: No, no, the greens were -- maybe right at the end of my round it seemed like the 17th green had firmed up somewhat, but overall the greens seemed pretty similar to what they were yesterday. I don't really know how to account for a little bit higher scoring today other than just yesterday it was totally calm, today there was a little breeze.
