

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: KENNY PERRY

Q. How would you compare play from yesterday to today?

KENNY PERRY: I played worse and scored better. Go figure. I hit it beautifully yesterday. I didn't miss a fairway and shot 2-under. Today I couldn't find the planet, I was in every tree, I hit every tree on this golf course and shot 3-under. So I mean, go figure. I putted beautifully today, I didn't putt very good yesterday. I drove it great yesterday, I drove it terrible today. So I'm going to go to the range, try to get it all to come together and look forward to it, we may have a good weekend. It was funny, I won here last year and I was 5-under after the first two rounds, and I'm 5-under again after the first two rounds so hopefully that's a good omen.

Q. They say that 18th hole was really tough yesterday. How was it treating you today?

KENNY PERRY: Good. I hit a driver and a pitching wedge 20 feet and two-putted for par. But it is a tough driving hole. There's water down the left and trees and bunkering down the right and it's the only fairway I hit. I hit a great drive right down the middle. I don't know, it's a crazy game we play.

Q. Do you change your approach at all being -- you're scoring well, but being five shots back?

KENNY PERRY: Yeah, it was kind of like Houston two weeks ago. I was in kind of, I call it the rocking chair where if you play great, you've got a chance to steal one, or if you don't, it's really no big deal. So the pressure's going to be on Kevin and Maggert tomorrow and they're going to have the bulk of the pressure on them. If I can freewheel it out there, go out there and shoot a 66 or something, something low, maybe I can catch up to them.
