

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW: MICHAEL ALLEN
Sunday, November 8, 2015



Q. Early on you didn't make your first birdie until I think 8, was it?

MICHAEL ALLEN: Yeah. I had good opportunities. I didn't hit a very good putt on 1. But after that, 2, the ball just falls below the hole. 3 I hit a great putt and just misread it a hair. 4 I got in there eight, 10 feet. I hit a lot of great shots with a lot of great opportunities. To me I feel I really hit my lines, hit the putts where I was trying to hit them. For some reason I wasn't reading them quite as well or whatever it was. I mean I felt like I put myself in position to win and I wasn't able to do it today. Maybe I made some ones I shouldn't have made earlier in the week and they didn't fall for me today, but I gave myself a good chance.

Q. You got an up-close-and-personal look at Langer for three days here. What's he do for an encore? He's won three of these now.

MICHAEL ALLEN: You know, it's like when I was talking to him on 17 going up to the hole, you know, finish off well. I talked to him because when he came out, he told me in Cleveland, his last tournament on the tour, he said, I'm going to the Champions Tour. I said, Why is that? You're still competitive, you finished fourth at Honda. He just said, I like having a chance to win every week. That's kind of what it's been for him. It's fun to come out here and have a chance so I was a little disappointed today things didn't turn out quite right, but it's fun. That's kind of why we play. So that kind of was his attitude and so I think he's just having a good time. He loves competing, he's obviously very competitive and it was a good week, it was a fun week. That's who he is, though. He's competitive, he likes to prepare and he likes training, he likes getting ready and he loves competing. He's good at it.
