Q. On this tour you see a lot of scores going up and down. I mean, certain guys get hot, stay hot. What's your battle plan going into the weekend?

BERNHARD LANGER: Oh, scores change all the time but they're usually pretty good. So my plan is to go low on the weekend. The scores, if there's not much wind, the scores are out there. If the wind kicks up, it's going to make it harder so I'm going to have to continue to play well and go low.

Q. What did you think of the crowds out there today?

BERNHARD LANGER: Fantastic, unbelievable for a Friday. I drove in here about 9:00 in the morning, there were cars lined up all the way down. It's great, it's really fun to see.

Q. Did you get delayed in that much?

BERNHARD LANGER: No, five minutes or so. Didn't matter to me, but later on some guys were a bit delayed.

Q. But you like that, don't you, you like big galleries?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, it's awesome, it's fantastic. The more, the merrier. It's great to see people come out and enjoy good golf.
