



ROUND 3 INTERVIEW:
June 25, 2016

WESLEY BRYAN

Q. Well, what is it about this course that's allowed you to have this success?

WESLEY BRYAN: I mean, Thursday I played really well, got off to a good start. Friday, went backwards a few steps. But then today, I mean, really if you hit fairways, the course is scoreable. There's going to be some numbers that can be shot, but when you get off the fairway, that's when the bogeys are bound to happen.

Q. And you've had the success today. How do you carry that over to tomorrow and to have a strong finish?

WESLEY BRYAN: I mean, you've got to get off to a good start. The front nine is where all the birdies are. I've kind of struggled on nine a little bit, but I mean, you've got to get a feel on the front nine if you want to have any chance to contend. Hopefully I can get off to a good start tomorrow and get the name crawling up the leaderboard a little bit and see what happens on the back nine.

Q. Do you have any prep or any specific rituals that you like to do before a tournament between now and then to ready yourself, make sure you can keep the streak up?

WESLEY BRYAN: No, it's just the same thing. The only ritual I have is after a win I go eat Taco Bell. So hopefully come tomorrow afternoon standing in the winner's circle and heading over to Taco Bell for a Crunchwrap Supreme.

Q. Now you're only 26 I think I saw?

WESLEY BRYAN: Yeah.

Q. What does it mean at such a young age to be playing in this tournament? I know it's a Tiger Woods tournament, he had success at a young age. How does that feel for you?

WESLEY BRYAN: When I had the call that Tiger had given me an invite here, I was extremely excited. I feel like I've got a lot of peers that have had a lot of success at a really young age and I feel like honestly I'm one of the older guys out here when I look around and see the DeChambeaus and Justin Thomas and Smylie and a lot of these younger guys having a lot of success. I mean, it's still golf, you've got to hit the fairway, got to hit the

green, you've got to make putts, but it's just fun to be out here.

Q. Obviously this is another great experience for you. Going forward through your whole career, what are you going to take from this tournament as you go forward?

WESLEY BRYAN: This one, it's a U.S. Open track out here. It's a good one to kind of be thrown into the deep end, so to speak, and just kind of keep my feet wet a little bit out here. This is I think my second PGA Tour start. Anytime you can test yourself on a U.S. Open track I think it prepares you going forward.
