**MIKE GOODES:** He just kept hitting, I tell you he's one of the best chippers I've ever seen. He hit it in the rough a few times around the greens and he would almost make it every time. On 16 he hit an incredible chip out of the right rough around the green for about three inches from the hole or something. He's just a great player, he deserves it.

**Q. It was quite a run there on the back nine, wasn't it?**

**MIKE GOODES:** Yeah, he played great. I don't know how many birdies he made. I was kind of busy, but I was keeping the score but I still don't know. He made a lot of birdies coming in, I do know that, and he made a great second putt on 17. Had a hard two-putt on the front part of the green and he must have run it by six feet or something and made -- he knew what it meant. Nobody had to tell him. He's a great player, he deserves it.
