



Q. Thank you for stopping here.

JEAN-FRANCOIS REMESY: Yeah, no problem, it's part of the job and I have to do that. And I think in about 15 minutes should be much better and, yeah, I'm disappointed because I didn't really play my game on the back nine and I was a little bit cramped and the putt didn't come so everything turn out not really bad way, but, you know, I was not good enough. That was the first time in contention, you know, and I try my best. I try my best. I cannot play one shot under that and so c'est la vie.

Q. Was there a hole or shot that you really felt might have cost you more?

JEAN-FRANCOIS REMESY: I think the break is on the 12th, you know, the par 3. I hit -- I don't know what's happening in my mind, I had the club and then I decided to do something, you know, manipulate the club or whatever and I make a bogey on that one. And after that, you know, I was looking for birdies and they didn't came. On 15 a stupid bogey, I know that route didn't make seven, it's always the same thing, but, you know, bogey on that sort of holes, it's not a key, you know. And after that I could not hole any putts, so it's difficult. I shoot 1-under. I didn't play -- the guys played well behind that. I knew that I have a plan to make 5-under to win and it was the right choice, but I didn't do it. Not this week.

Q. 15 played very easy all week. What went into your club selection and what did you do on the tee shot?

JEAN-FRANCOIS REMESY: On 15, 15 is a drive and cut. Didn't cut, that's it. It went like this. Yesterday I make it on the green and today is just a lot of things like we see on the putt, I didn't get the right speed on the greens because of, you know, little bit of tension, a little bit of everything, a little bit of many years having been in that position, but I always come back, I always come back and I will win. I hope so.

Q. You will take positives away from this week?

JEAN-FRANCOIS REMESY: Of course, it's a tough turn. I don't have to go for the (inaudible) I think normally, so I mean I stayed in the next one. And I'm going to focus right now for the qualifying on Thursday for the U.S. Open, that's it, you know. Tomorrow is another day and this one is finish. Certainly disappointing, but I prove myself that I can be here, so that's the best thing for me and I will come back and I will perform.

Q. Are you doing the qualifying here in Wisconsin for the U.S. Senior Open?

JEAN-FRANCOIS REMESY: Yeah, it's in on Tuesday -- on Thursday, I don't know where, but an hour from here. Yeah, I'm going over there.
