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**Q. J.T. eagle the first, bogey the second and then just smooth sailing. Solid out here at Riviera.**

**J.T. POSTON:** Yeah, it was kind of one of those days felt really comfortable out there, felt like I could hit any shot. The bogey on 2 was just a bad tee ball and kind of got stuck behind a tree and didn't have much. Other than that, it was a pretty solid round of golf. Pretty happy with it.

**Q. Trees out here at Riviera are bigger than most, aren't they?**

**J.T. POSTON:** Yeah, definitely. They get in the way pretty easily.

**Q. How many times have you been around this track?**

**J.T. POSTON:** First time, Tuesday was the first time seeing it because I Mondayed in and so I was kind of late getting out here than most people. But touched them all on Tuesday and I love it. It's probably top-5 favorite course I've played.

**Q. Most people don't understand these greens, it's hard to figure them out but you had the feel early, are you a southern California kid, kind of understand what goes on when you're near the coast?**

**J.T. POSTON:** I'm not a southern Cal kid, I'm an east coast kid from North Carolina, but I don't know, my feel's just been good, the speed has been good, and once you see a few go in early definitely confidence is up and that was the case for me.

**Q. So this is your 10th event?**

**J.T. POSTON:** Um-hmm.

**Q. (inaudible) spending the season on the Web.com?**

**J.T. POSTON:** Yeah, about half a season, two-thirds.

**Q. So what's the transition been like for you?**

**J.T. POSTON:** It's been awesome. There's definitely a lot more distractions out here and just a lot more going on in general. Crowds are bigger. But the golf is still the same. The golf courses I don't think -- this might be a little bit bigger of a golf course, but the ones I had played previously that if you hit the ball good, you can go low. So the golf, once I kind of get the distractions aside, the golf hasn't been much different. But I'm having a blast, I love it.

It's been a dream of mine.

**Q. Looks like it's been pretty steady for you out here. You missed a couple cuts but your finishes have been pretty steady. Are you happy with your progression?**

**J.T. POSTON:** A little bit. Starting out in the fall I was pretty happy with the fall. I think I made three out of five cuts, but I just have been looking for kind of that week where I put it all together. You know, one week I may not be hitting the tee ball good and short game's been great, or the next week hitting it good enough to post some of the numbers but then just putter going cold. Just haven't put four rounds together really. But I feel like I can do it. I know that -- I mean I've had some good rounds, just not four in a row, so just looking to put a tournament together.

**Q. You played with a pair of Kevins today, particularly Kevin Hall. I wanted to ask you about what was that experience like, had you met him before today?**

**J.T. POSTON:** I had not met Kevin. I think I had played in a couple of mini-tour events at the beginning of last year, maybe the end of two years ago and had seen him out there but had never met him. But he's definitely an inspiration. It's really cool to see somebody like that persevere and, you know, go out and chase his dream like everybody else. I think it's awesome he's got a shot this week.

**Q. Did you guys all converse in some way out there today? I know there's obviously some difficulties in that respect.**

**J.T. POSTON:** Yeah, it's difficult, but yeah, give him a thumbs-up when he hits a good shot. You know, I think the first couple holes he had some galleries, some people following him and I tried to pick up on some of the stuff that they were doing as like applause and they kind of do this (indicating.) But yeah, I gave him a thumbs-up whenever I could. I think it's awesome.
