

**ROUND 1 INTERVIEW: LEE JANZEN (-7)**  
**May 18, 2017**

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**Q. Going in at 7 under, what did you feel like was working best for you out there today?**

**LEE JANZEN:** I hit the ball really well. You know, there's two parts of the game, you figure out what you want to do and what shot you want to hit, and then the hard part is actually doing it. So when the ball actually goes where you want it to go and does exactly what you want it to do more than a few times during a round, it just makes for a better day. It's hard not to shoot a good score when you've got that kind of control, when the ball's landing the distance you want, you're keeping it below the hole and playing it on the proper side of the hole and proper side of the fairway all day long.

**Q. So you must be happy?**

**LEE JANZEN:** It's a good start. If I can hit the ball like that every day, it would make live really easy on the golf course.

**Q. We've kind of gotten mixed opinions as far as what kind of a score based off today it's going to take to win this. It was 17 under last year. If conditions hold out like they've been, is it safe to assume that 17 might not hold up this time around?**

**LEE JANZEN:** Well, yeah, I don't know what's coming but the golf course is in fantastic condition, better than last year, which may help scoring. The greens are better so it's easier to make putts. They're a little faster, but they're also rolling so much better. So if guys are on their game, if their technique's really good and they're hitting the putt where they're aiming, they're going to make more putts so that will help the scoring.

**Q. Around 18 on the green, it's not quiet. Do you hear anything of that or are you able to be that focused?**

**LEE JANZEN:** It would be easier if it was just a constant noise. It's when it gets real quiet and all of a sudden there's a commotion maybe that breaks out or an unusual noise. But usually the constant noise that maybe goes on in the tents right above a green really isn't that big a deal, it's just the odd noise that jumps out. Some guys are just oblivious to all of it. Sometimes when my concentration's good I don't hear it and other times I hear absolutely everything, so I don't know if I have a good answer for that.
