

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW: SCOTT McCARRON (-9)
May 19, 2017



Q. How did you feel about the round today?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, you know, I didn't play very good today. I didn't drive it in play on the front side so I was kind of struggling to get it close. Then I played a couple nice holes on the back side. It's unfortunate the three-putt on the last hole for par, but all in all it was just an okay day. It could have been a little better, it could have been a little worse.

Q. But you've got to feel good about going into the weekend, at the moment two shots off?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, yeah, I'm two shots off. Scott Parel played a real nice round today and backed it up, he had another one the first day. So I'm going to have to go out there and play well this weekend. We've got some weather coming in, we're going to go a little early. But I sure like this golf course and hopefully the weather stays away.

Q. When you've got a guy who surges at the top like that on day two, does that mess with you a little bit mentally?

SCOTT McCARRON: Not at all, especially with a four-day tournament. Being a major, there's a lot of golf left. You know someone's going to go low after two days, and Scott played two nice really good rounds there. A couple shots back, we'll see what the guys do behind us, but I'm in a good position going into the weekend.

Q. 18's been cruel today. What's the --

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, I hit two great shots on 18. I had 45 feet just coming down the hill and almost made it. I thought I made it, but the ball just rolled out about six feet past actually and then missed the next come-backer. The breeze is coming back in your face so it's a tough drive, and with that hole location being on the front of the green, it's tough to get it close.
