

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW
June 24, 2017



Doug Garwood (-6)

Q. It gets people's attention, what was the key in that stretch?

DOUG GARWOOD: Started hitting the irons really good. Hit it close on 13, I hit it close on 14, I hit it close on 15, I hit it close on 16, I hit it close on 17 and kind of close on 18, so I made it easy. But still had to make, you know, three- to eight-footers, so it was fun.

Q. When was the last time you made six in a row?

DOUG GARWOOD: You know, probably last year at some point, I think, yeah.

Q. Is that an indication of what the course is giving in that stretch of the course, or was it what you were giving yourself in that stretch of the course?

DOUG GARWOOD: It's probably both. You know, the scores were pretty low yesterday. If you're in the fairway, the course doesn't play super long, there's a lot of shorter clubs and so you can score. That stretch particularly, 13's a shorter hole, 15's shorter, 16's reachable. The birdie on 17, I probably maybe get the "closie" today. I was about eight feet, too. It was just playing tough and just over that water so everyone wants to hit it past it. The wind was a factor and so I was impressed with myself. (Laughter.)

Q. If Broadhurst doesn't get too far away, how close do you need to be to really feel like you've got a shot on Sunday?

DOUG GARWOOD: No idea. I haven't even thought about it, to be honest, because they still have nine holes to play. Could be eight back, could be two back. Whatever it is, I'll just tee it up and go play my best.

Q. Is this course conducive to maybe making a run at any given time?

DOUG GARWOOD: I think so. Yeah, the greens are perfect. If you're striking it well, you're going to have birdie putts. As I said, there are some short holes that you can attack and so it's doable.

Q. There's low and then there's the insanely low like you've seen on tour this year. Can this tour get to that on a course like this, talking 60s, 61s?

DOUG GARWOOD: Not with this wind, there's too much wind. If there's no wind, yeah, then you're going to scare 'em. Guys shot 63 with some wind yesterday, but generally I think this is a pretty tough wind for this course and it will keep it away from that low number.
