Q. Sometimes people come out here, they're surprised at the 66s and 63s yesterday. I know you're not. I mean, that's just the level of play and how good this tour is.

JERRY KELLY: These guys shoot low every single week. It's pretty impressive the scores that come out. I didn't think there was going to be another 17 this week. It's going to be lower. I mean, that's just the way it is. You know, we started the slogan "These guys are good." They're living up to it.

Q. Jerry, what's doable for you tomorrow?

JERRY KELLY: 8, 10 under, absolutely. It's out there. It's what I'm going to try and shoot. I don't know what else to tell you guys. I'm trying, bottom line.

Q. Is the course any different today, playing any different with the wind?

JERRY KELLY: Oh, yeah. Well, the difference is you didn't have ball-in-hand, so a couple shots had mud and it starts getting into your head that you have to push it over there and make sure it doesn't go over there. Definitely, definitely works you a little bit. But there were -- it's a shifty wind. It wasn't that easy. I didn't make the putts. If you're not putting, that's what happens.
