

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

ZAC BLAIR (-9)

Q. Zac, great playing, man. Good round today but clean card, that's keeping the ball in the right spots when you miss one.

ZAC BLAIR: Yeah, like you say, I kept it in some good spots, didn't miss too many greens today and clean card.

Q. Not too many, I think I counted one.

ZAC BLAIR: Yeah, I hit a kind of a bad shot over there on 7 but left it in the right spot, had some green to work with and got it up and down.

Q. I made a joke, I said he hasn't missed a green all day but he left no doubt about this one. Wasn't a very good shot but if that's going to be your bad shot, you miss it on the proper side, that's the key?

ZAC BLAIR: Yeah, fat side, had plenty of room to work with. It was a pretty easy chip, honestly, and hit a good one.

Q. You hit so many good shots today. How hard was it today to stay patient? You hit so many shots that didn't go. This could have been a special day?

ZAC BLAIR: Yeah, just kind of one of those things you've just got to keep hitting good shots, keep rolling it nice where you're looking and if they go in, that's great. If not, tap-in pars and move on.

Q. With the guy who had birdie putt after birdie putt today. Seemingly how would you characterize your round?

ZAC BLAIR: Yeah, just had a lot of good looks. 17 greens out there, left myself in some good spots and made a few of them but just kind of was pretty easy. Didn't have too many tough looks, which was nice.

Q. Pretty amazing, you've gone 36 holes with a clean card. How would you be able to keep that up?

ZAC BLAIR: Like I said, just kind of missing it in the right spots the few times that I've missed and just try to get as many easy looks as I can.

Q. What did going through the Web.com Finals do for you to then start your PGA

Tour season right now?

ZAC BLAIR: No break, just kind of keep things rolling. Kind of know how I'm playing and know what's going on, so it's just kind of another week, get back at it.
