Like I say, if you're out of place on the tee shot, it's going to punish you.

Q. Xander played well today, his putting was on fire?

GAVIN GREEN: He putted good, yeah. It was fun to see him making putts. Justin was missing a couple of those also, he was on the same bus as me, missing a couple putts. We were a little bit off on the approach shots, but other than that I think it was fun. I enjoyed myself today with them.
