



KEVIN NA (-6)

Q. 6-under 66, talk us through your round.

KEVIN NA: I played really great today. Got off to a good start, made some birdies on the par 5s where I needed to, hit some great close iron shots to some tap-in birdies. Holed out on 16 for an eagle, that was nice. A little disappointed to finish with a bogey on a par 5, it's a birdie hole, and I just hit a really bad second shot and didn't club myself very well. Caught a flyer, flew over the green and poor chip, poor putt. So I didn't do very good on the last hole, but besides that I played very well.

Q. Talk us through that eagle on 16.

KEVIN NA: I had 116 yards to the hole. My 54-degree flies probably 110 max. I know it's running away, pitching away so I had to give it a couple yards extra. Flew it probably 112, 113 and one-hopped. I couldn't see it, but the group on the other tee, they started going nuts so I knew it was in the hole.

Q. How much of this week is dealing with the weather and the conditions?

KEVIN NA: It was nice to get off early and get the round over with. I know there's a storm coming and there's going to be storms here in the afternoon, but the weekend looks good. The scores are going to be low, you've got to keep going, so we'll see how it goes.

Q. And how do you carry this momentum into the last three rounds?

KEVIN NA: Just one round, so I've got to drive it better. I didn't drive it all that great today, or I drove it okay but I didn't feel that good. So I'm going to maybe put a different driver in play tomorrow. But I'm putting well, so if I can keep this up I'll be good.
