Q. Poom, bogey-free 65, talk us through your round.

POOM SAKSANSIN: I feel this one is event for me, but this one is no cut line so like 50 percent pressure is what I feel.

Q. And it's a very long course, your iron play was obviously very, very good today to post such a great score?

POOM SAKSANSIN: I think long course is the only hole 13, that's very long and the rest is okay for me.

Q. And what's your plan heading into the rest of the tournament?

POOM SAKSANSIN: Try to play good.

Q. Can you talk me through your round a little bit?

POOM SAKSANSIN: Today I hit a lot of good putt and a lot of good iron and I have a lot of (inaudible.)

Q. You had a really strong back nine, the front nine on the course, you shot a 30. How important is it to get off to a fast start at a tournament like this?

POOM SAKSANSIN: I putt good but I expect nothing, just try to hit close and make some putt, but hole a lot.

Q. What are you trying to do the rest of this week?
