

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW**

**JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND (-5)**

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**Q. Jazz, nice way to end your second round with birdie on the last hole to move up to 5 under. Your thoughts on the last two rounds here at CIMB Classic?**

**JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND:** I mean, playing on PGA TOUR is very high standard so my score's still in the level that's in the pack still, so I'm still far off the lead. So I'll just try and play my best out there tomorrow.

**Q. 2 under the first day, 3 under the today, 5 under total. I'm sure you're still proud of what you've done over the last two days?**

**JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND:** Yeah, it's an improvement for sure from the first PGA TOUR events I played this year. Played quite bad there, now I play better here so I'm happy with it. But I left a lot of puts out there that should have gone in, but still happy with my round.

**Q. When you started today, were you expecting this rainy conditions?**

**JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND:** Oh, it's been a long day. I woke up like 5:30 this morning and now it's 5:30 again, 12 hours on the course, yeah.

**Q. But I guess such conditions suit you well as well, this wet conditions and cooler as compared to yesterday?**

**JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND:** Well, I mean, playing in Asia we have to face this rain on and off all the time, so it can help some Asian player got some advantage over.

**Q. And during the three hours suspension, what was going through your mind?**

**JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND:** We know we're going to have a stop for sure in Malaysia, so we've just got to rest as much as we can during the time and just keep our mind off golf. Play some games. They've got darts, they've got ping pong, they've got table tennis, they've got bowling ball here.
