JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND (-11)

Q. Jazz, 6 under today. Take us through your round.

JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND: I started off really good today, par, par, and then birdied the par 5, birdied the par 3, birdied the next par 5. It's just a good kickstart to my round and end the round pretty good, too.

Q. You were much better on the greens today. What changed?

Q. At the start of the week when we spoke you said you were really just happy to be playing at this event, just happy to just be here. Now you're right there in contention. Has your objective changed?

JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND: Well, I guess I want to go out there and have fun, get into play, play well and then get to play with a couple great players today, so I don't think I (inaudible).

Q. A strong finish (inaudible)?

JAZZ JANEWATTANANOND: Yeah, that will help for sure, but it's not on the top of my mind. Just hope I get a good group together and get to play with other great players.
