

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

VIJAY SINGH (-11)

Q. Course record here. What was going well for you today?

VIJAY SINGH: I drove it well, hit my irons quite nice and putted nicely. I got my putter going, and anytime you putt well when you have so many opportunities, you're going to make a good score.

Q. You had four straight birdies at one point in the front nine. What was that like putting that string together?

VIJAY SINGH: It was early I made a bogey on, what was that, 3. I missed a very short putt there and made two long putts and then hit -- the par 5 I got it on in two. I had a very good chance for eagle and missed that, and then birdied the ninth hole as well. So the par 5s have been good to me.

Q. Coming down the final three, you were able to recover there and get two birdies. Going into this last day tomorrow there at the top (inaudible.)

VIJAY SINGH: Yeah, the guys have got a lot of holes to go and the par 5s are playing reasonably well, short. So coming in you've got two short holes as well, 13 and 15. So there's a lot of birdie opportunities, you just have to capitalize and make as many as you can and see what happens.

Q. When you shoot a 63 and tie the course record, before you start a round, do you feel something special's coming or as the round progresses maybe?

VIJAY SINGH: Not really. I wasn't even thinking about it. I just looked up at the leaderboard and, you know, Langer keeps making birdies, so I said I've got to keep making birdies. I know he's going to be well over 11 by the end day. I'll probably be three or four back, but it's gettable tomorrow.
