HENRIK STENSON (-3)

Q. How did your caddie work out?

HENRIK STENSON: She's prettier than Gareth. Next question?

Q. The four-putt seemed to kind of inspire you, was it anger or --

HENRIK STENSON: No, I was happy with that. Put me in a nice mood for the next seven holes.

Yeah, I putted four times on one hole and then I had four one-putts after it, so I guess it all kind of evened out in the end.

Q. Did you use your energy, anger?

HENRIK STENSON: Yeah, there have been very few times over the years, sometimes it can lead to a few birdies and sometimes it can lead to a couple of bogeys. I guess this time it led to a couple of birdies. The greens were definitely quicker today, I think they must have prepped them slightly different. I don't know if any of the other guys have mentioned that but they were slick. It was a noticeable difference compared to yesterday and the day before. So you really had to be cautious, downwind you had a bit of longer putts that were just floating away really. It was kind of major championship speed on some of them.

Q. Was the wind any different today?

HENRIK STENSON: It's kind of the same, which makes this golf course a little tricky because it's straight crosswind pretty much every day, for the pro-am, yesterday and today. So you don't really get any down or straight into the wind. The majority of the holes are just off the left or off the right. Yeah, you've got to be on there if you want to get it close. Yeah, I hit some good shots, but all in all it was a bit sloppy and left too many shots out there to post a good number.

Q. What did you see out of Tiger?

HENRIK STENSON: Yeah, I thought he was playing nicely. He got it going on the front nine for sure. Maybe not the finish he would have liked. I think he was probably feeling like he would have liked to get into double digits the way he played there. But a lot of positives and he hit some fantastic shots. That second shot into 9 and that eagle he made there. Early on he stuffed it really close with a couple of wedges and holed a couple of crucial putts on one or two occasions where he was a little off on the speed as well and he made the

return. So a lot of positives on the way he played I'd say.
