**Q. Kevin, another great round today. Tell us about your round and how you felt.**

**KEVIN NA:** I got off to a great start with an eagle on 1. Pin was very accessible and I just kept it going, I made a lot of putts, just didn't miss a shot. And then nice birdie on 10 and 5 under looking good. And then 12, I caught a flyer that -- we haven't really caught a flyer all week and 12 and 13, both flyers over the green. You just can't put yourself there. The wheels were coming off. And 14 out of that bunker, I was thinking positive, felt like I was going to make it. When you think positive, positive things happen. I think that was what saved my day. Then I went on to make a nice birdie on 17 and a good par save on 18.

**Q. Tell us more about that hole-out on 14, a great reaction to your caddie. Just tell us what was going through your head.**

**KEVIN NA:** I got there and I said, "I'm going to make this, I'm going to hoop this one." I hit it, and right when I hit it I said, "This is perfect, go in," and I looked up and I could see it just barely crawl to the hole and catch the right side and it goes in and I just keep screaming to my caddie, "I told you, I told you."

**Q. How important was that after a rough couple holes to turn your round back around?**

**KEVIN NA:** That saved the day. If it wasn't for that, maybe I don't get up and down, make another bogey. I mean, who knows what could have happened to me. 15's a difficult hole, 18's a difficult hole. I mean, I could have probably blew my chances of having any chance tomorrow, so I'm right there.
