

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW
March 31, 2018



EMILIANO GRILLO (-12)

Q. Emiliano, what a nice tidy round and a beautiful two-putt there on the 18th.

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, it was definitely the last two holes were very tough. 17, 18's playing tough. I was able to make a great up-and-down on 17 and a great two-putt there on 18 to walk away with no bogeys today so that makes it very good.

Q. You mentioned no bogeys today, no bogeys in the opening round as well. In fact, you don't have a bogey all week. You did have a double bogey on Friday, but you've been very consistent helped by your scrambling, five for five when missing greens here.

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, we've been working really hard to get that area of the game improving. It's definitely my weakness of the game, so I'm glad to see that it's working this week and I'm glad to be up there making some putts as well.

Q. Tell me how the course is playing. What holes we should look out for as this day progresses?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Like I said, 17, 18 is playing very hard. You've got I think none of the par 5s you can reach in two except for 8, so you have to chip well out there from 60 to 100 yards. If you do that you're going to have a lot of chances out there. There's some easy holes there and some very hard holes, like I say. 16 is playing very hard as well today.

Q. Emiliano, excellent round again today, just get some comments if we can, please?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Oh, yeah, played very well today. It's getting windy out there. Had to be very patient and I was able to do that. Made some good putts on the back nine and I was able to hold on on 17, 18, they're playing very tough. 17, the tee's in the back, it's playing a bit longer than the past two days. Very pleased with the way I handled myself out there.

Q. Your thoughts heading into tomorrow's final round?

EMILIANO GRILLO: I've just got to go out and do the same. Fairways are going to be key, just stay patient and shot by shot.

Q. What was the biggest key for you today, what worked for you out there today? Everybody loves the course, but --

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, the course is in great shape, that's out of the question. Here off

the tee I kept the ball in front of me all day and that's key out here. You can make a double pretty easy out there if you're not on the fairway.
