

ROUND 3 INTERVIEW

ANDREW LANDRY (-10)

Q. Can you talk about the key of the scoring and how was it?

ANDREW LANDRY: Yeah, that was obviously a good day out there today. Played very, very well. A couple putts there that I should have made but didn't get them, but played really solid golf and that was kind of what I wanted to do heading into tomorrow. So just finish it off with a birdie and get myself one group further back and see what we can do, chasing Abe down.

Q. Was the heat affecting you?

ANDREW LANDRY: We just tried to stay hydrated. It's really, really hot out there right now. Yeah, you definitely feel a little dizzy out there every now and then. You've just got to make sure you're hydrated, Gatorade, drink some water, stuff like that.

Q. What was the difference between yesterday's round and today's round?

ANDREW LANDRY: Honestly, I hit the ball really good yesterday. If you go back and just look at my stats from hole by hole, I was right there, and today just putts went in. So everything didn't go in, but I'm going to need probably one of those days tomorrow to really capitalize on another win. But I'm not putting any pressure on myself. The putter felt really good today, it just felt really bad yesterday.

Q. How much do you lean on your Tour win going into tomorrow having a shot, being in contention?

ANDREW LANDRY: Yeah, it's obviously a really good thing to be in that position a couple times this year and get one of them, lose in a playoff in another. I just think that I know what to do now and I know how to handle myself and handle my nerves and I know what it takes, and so far it is -- the days have gone and it's definitely there. So it's there for the taking tomorrow, you've just got to go out and have a really good day.

Q. Is it yourself discipline or you have a coach for this?

ANDREW LANDRY: It's just discipline, I guess. Yeah, you can say it's that. You've just got to be really, really patient out there, take advantage of the back nine. The back nine's really gettable. There's some holes on the front nine, I don't know how the wind is going to be tomorrow, but there's some holes on the front nine that can easily bite you and I played really well on the front nine today.
