JON RAHM (-6)



Q. Jon, how would you assess today's performance?

JON RAHM: Extremely good tee to green. I didn't make a single putt. Made one on the first hole from 10 feet and a three-footer and that's it. I hit good putts, too. I mean, I lipped out on 16, 17 and 18. All three of them touched the hole. I mean, barely -- almost made it on 14. Nothing went in. It's about as worse a round I could have shot today, to be honest. There's no other way to look at it. Played way too good tee to green and just didn't make the putts.

Q. Giving yourself those chances, though, can you take some positives from that going into the weekend?

JON RAHM: Yeah, I will take a lot of positive. Right now I'm frustrated. It's very frustrating to finish the way I did. I mean, I hit a perfect drive on 18, a great wedge shot to 10 feet, not even 10 feet, and just -- I don't know if there was a bump, a misread, whatever it was. Just lipped it out. I mean, could have been a lot better today than what it was, I'll tell you that. I'm frustrated. It's hard to focus on the positive right now. In a couple hours I'll be fine.
