



SCOTT PIERCY (-7)

Q. Well, another good round here at TPC Kuala Lumpur. What is it about this place that you seem to like so much?

SCOTT PIERCY: The heat and there's a lot of kind of short wedge holes, kind of drive it straight and shorter irons. My irons are kind of my strong suit and I've been driving it well. Today I was grateful to see some putts go in. Like to see some more of that if possible.

Q. Obviously the course is playing a little more difficult now with the changes and also not having ball in hand. How does that round compare to the 62 you shot in 2015?

SCOTT PIERCY: Was that on this golf course or a different one?

Q. I think it was on this one.

SCOTT PIERCY: Okay.

Q. I think it was. 10 under 62, 2015?

SCOTT PIERCY: Maybe, yeah. I forgot about that. So many 62s.

I've struggled of late, to be quite honest. To put up a good round today felt really good. That was like shooting 62 for me today, I just really haven't got it in the hole very well. Seeing it go in the hole was just really good for me right now.

Q. What were you working on those weeks before the new season started?

SCOTT PIERCY: You know what, the ball-striking's been pretty good really. It's been around the green and on the green, just haven't been able to find that little thing to kind of put me over the edge. I feel like maybe today I got a little something. Just practice a little bit afterwards and try to ingrain a little bit, try a little different feels. But the game's pretty close, it's been pretty close for a while. Definitely going in the hole makes a big difference.

Q. You've had three top-10s here in four starts. Were you pretty excited to come here knowing your success there in the past?

SCOTT PIERCY: Yeah, you know, not only just for that. I missed the cut last week at Safeway, which is one of my favorite events, just same thing, couldn't get in the hole. A lot of good shots, a lot of -- so the game's been feeling good, it's just I get four rounds here,

kind of help get some momentum, four rounds next week, then Vegas, my home course, then Mayakoba where I've had some pretty good success as well. I feel like this is kind of a good stretch of events for me to get it going. What happened today was really nice.
