Q. Can you talk to us about that 4-under round?

AUSTIN COOK: I got started off really hot there. A little disappointed with 4 with how I started, but all in all, depending on what they do on the last hole, I'm three or four shots back from the lead so got a good chance going into tomorrow with a low score.

Q. What was different on the back nine?

AUSTIN COOK: Made a couple bogeys and just didn't make some of the putts. Putts were close to going in, but they just kind of went over the edge.

Q. There's a few still behind you on the golf course. Are you in a good position on the final day?

AUSTIN COOK: Yeah, definitely. An 8, 9 under tomorrow will, if not win, be really close to winning. So looking forward to coming out tomorrow and just kind of going out, going at pins and trying to go low.

AUSTIN COOK: Yeah, it's definitely key to get going early. In a round like that you want to go low, but there's a good stretch of short holes on the back side that you've got to take advantage of.

AUSTIN COOK: Oh, yeah, hitting the ball good enough. Only had one bad shot today, I bladed a 60 degree and kind of went 50, 60 yards too long. Besides that, I hit the ball great, still putted well.

The other bogey I had was today 16, the drivable one, and I just hit driver, it landed five feet from the pin but rolled over the green into the water and then I three-putted. You kind of take that away and I had a great round, just a couple small mistakes. Take those away and it would be a 7 under instead of 4 under.
