**BEN LEONG:** No, not really, I try not to think about it. The more I think about it, the more frustrated I will get definitely. Struggling with my golf swing a bit, but I know what's going on. My coach came in and had a look actually this week and I know what I need to work on, but not the right time. Yeah, we'll figure it out.

**Q. Ben, one of the things you need to work on are 10 to 15 foot putts?**

**BEN LEONG:** Yeah, I agree. A little bit of chipping, a little bit of wedge game, a little bit of putting. We'll work on that definitely.

**Q. So it was a pretty up-and-down day today?**

**BEN LEONG:** It's been an up-and-down week actually, but that's golf. You don't play well every day, but make sure when you don't play well, at least you're scoring. That's the secret. Everyone's going to play -- they're going to shoot low scores when they play well. The key is definitely putting a good number even though you're not playing well.

**Q. I was like super impressed with the 50-foot putt right there, it was amazing. How long was that?**

**BEN LEONG:** How long was it? About 60 feet maybe, maybe more. Like I said, try not to look at it too much, I mean, the line, so I just went up there and hit the putt. Fortunately, it went in.

**Q. Okay. Like yesterday you said that you wanted to change it up, but today what did you do different? Was there anything that you did?**

**BEN LEONG:** Nothing really. Like reset it, 10, 11 and 12, that's my jinx hole, I suppose. Yeah, you know, things happen for a reason. You might make birdies there and bogey like different holes, but it all adds up at the end of the day, so let's not get too carried away with

it, yeah.

**Q. So your expectation last day tomorrow?**

**BEN LEONG:** Definitely there's expectation, but we'll try to ignore that, put the ball in the fairway, put it on the green and try to make the putt. Just control what I can do.

**Q. You had a front row see watching Stewart Cink. How good was that for you?**

**BEN LEONG:** It didn't look like a 9 under actually. He made it look so easy. Definitely impressive. He's been on the PGA TOUR for -- he's a major champion, he's been on Tour for a century now, I suppose. It's fun, it's good to look at. Definitely I learned a thing or two definitely.
