



LOUIS OOSTHUIZEN (-17)

Q. Louis Oosthuizen, 7 under par today. What was the key to the round?

LOUIS OOSTHUIZEN: I started a quick start really, 4 under through five, and then sort of just quiet from there until the 10th. But yeah, played solid, giving myself a lot of opportunities. I think I only missed one green in regulation today, so I've been hitting the irons really good. Just giving myself loads of opportunities and making a few putts. So it's always going to be low scoring around here, greens are perfect for putting conditions. Probably need another low one tomorrow to have a chance.

Q. Just a couple behind right now of the lead. Is the course giving up enough birdies out there for you to really stick yourself in it right from the get-go?

LOUIS OOSTHUIZEN: Definitely. I think the start's crucial through that first seven holes. You know, won't be surprised if someone goes 5, 6 under in the first seven holes. But yeah, I mean, it's definitely a lot of birdies out there, so the guy that's going to roll in the putts is definitely going to have a good chance.

Q. Is it an advantage, do you think, having won here at TPC Kuala Lumpur when you go into the final day tomorrow?

LOUIS OOSTHUIZEN: The golf course is completely different. Greens are different, grass is different in the fairways, but like I said, I love the layout, I like the golf course and I just need to play the same as I've played the last three days.
