



GARY WOODLAND (-19)

Q. Gary, just thoughts on having a share of the 54-hole lead?

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, it's nice. I played very well today. Didn't make as many putts as I did yesterday, but drove the ball well. Kind of got a little loose there a little bit on the back nine, maybe ran out of gas a little, but it was nice to finish up with a birdie and nice to get some momentum going into tomorrow.

Q. Two runner-ups here before, how bad do you want to get this one done tomorrow?

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, it would be nice. I love this golf course, I love coming here, the people are great, food's great, the golf course is phenomenal. They've done a phenomenal job with the redo. It's in as good of shape as I've ever seen. Sets up for a great day tomorrow and hopefully we can go out and have a good round, see what happens.

Q. A real nice last hole there, striped the drive, good putt there?

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, it's key to get the ball in the fairway there. Par 5s out here I can take advantage of, I can get home there easily. Hit 5-wood in there, so nice to drive the ball in the fairway, especially on the par 5s and be able to attack from there.

Q. Gary, it's like groundhog day heading into the final round at CIMB Classic and you're in contention yet again.

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, it's nice. This golf course sets up good to my eye. I've been playing well coming in. It's nice to be in contention and have a chance tomorrow. Excited about my game and where I'm at.

Q. Marc said it may take up to 25 under. Do you have a number in your mind?

GARY WOODLAND: No. You're going to have to make birdies. The golf course is in great shape, the weather's been perfect, so if that all stays the same, we're going to have to go out and be aggressive and make some birdies. Four par 5s out here and some holes you've got a lot of wedges into, so birdies are going to be (inaudible) and hopefully I'll make the most.

Q. And then lastly, playing with the same two tomorrow, just talk about the pairings.

GARY WOODLAND: Yeah, today we kind of fed off each other. Leish got off to an unbelievable start and we kind of hung in there. He played phenomenal early, got off to a perfect start. Leish and I played a lot of golf together, so we're comfortable there.
