



EMILIANO GRILLO (-21)

Q. Emiliano, summarize your day for us with that round, final round of yours.

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, I started playing very well, I shot 30 on the front nine. I was starting the round today saying if I could shoot 7 under it would give me the chance. Unfortunately, I wasn't able to play as well on the back nine, but four rounds in the 60s is always good, especially in a place like this.

Q. Is that a reflection of how the golf course is, a little bit more gettable on the back nine, a little bit more tricky on the back?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yes, yes, the front is definitely easier. You've got a lot of short holes there, you can take advantage of it. Then on the back nine you've just got to hold on and hit -- you've got to hit perfect shots on the back nine, especially 11, 12, all the way through 16 you've got to play very well.

Q. This is a great start to your new season on the PGA TOUR 2018-19. How important is it to get points on the FedExCup standings early in the year?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Very important. It's different. I mean, it's not the same playing with your card on the line than having a lot of points in the beginning. Of course that's always the idea is to get the most points out of it every week and this week was pretty good in that matter.

Q. And in the context of the Presidents Cup, counts towards the rankings as well. I mean, with Ernie Els here this week, who you played the first two rounds with, how much fun was it?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, definitely, playing with Ernie is always a plus. Playing well and playing with Ernie was a double plus. Yeah, we still have a year of points, this is only the beginning. Hopefully we can keep it on this path and be on the team, but that will definitely be a goal for next year.

Q. Would that be one of your goals to try and achieve in 2019, to get back on the international team?
