**Q. Brooks, just quick comments about your round today?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** I felt like I played good. I hit some good shots, missed a couple putts early and kind put myself in a little bit of trouble on the back nine, my front, but rallied pretty nicely. I felt like I found a bit of rhythm. But it's a difficult day, anything under par, level par is a good score out there today. I'm pleased with it.

**Q. And it was super windy out there and cold. How did that affect your score today?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** I mean, we knew the ball was going to be blowing around. It's tough on these greens. These greens are actually quite quick and if you start downhill downwind, it's actually quite tough to get the ball to stop. The ninth hole there, I mean, I didn't have a chance of stopping that putt on the green. But it's difficult to make putts and you're always trying to leave yourself into the wind so you can give yourself a good run or a good luck.

**Q. Were there a lot of Korean fans, galleries. How was their supporting?**

**BROOKS KOEPKA:** Yeah, it was nice to have them out. Obviously they're very respectful. It's nice to have respectful fans following you. They're very supportive, which is nice. You know, look forward to having them out the rest of the week. Who knows, maybe the crowds will get bigger and bigger, which will be nice.
