

RAFA CABRERA BELLO (-15)

Q. Quite a nice way to finish for a top-3 finish here at the CJ Cup?

RAFA CABRERA BELLO: Yeah, very happy obviously, played really good over the weekend. I mean, it was a pity not to feel that I was in contention because kind of Brooks and Gary, an amazing day today, it was impossible to catch up with them. But overall, very, very pleased with my performance. A T-3 finish is a great way to start the season.

Q. What was the difference on the back nine? Front nine was even par.

RAFA CABRERA BELLO: The front nine I shot 1 under. I played good, just I felt some putts didn't drop. I could have started really, really strong on the first three, four holes. Had a bit of bad luck on 9 and ended up with a bogey there, but overall I played steady. On the back nine there was to be a difference, my iron play was really, really good. I hit three, four shots in a row very, very close and gave myself really, really good chances.

Q. This event starts the new 2018-19 PGA TOUR season. In your context, how important is it to get off to a good start for the new season?

RAFA CABRERA BELLO: It's not mandatory or it's not definitive, but it is nice for sure to get off to a good start. For me, that I play both PGA TOUR and European Tour, it helps me a lot. It takes a little bit of pressure off the next few months that I don't play so much PGA TOUR, so it's nice to get some points up on the board.

Q. Just talk a little bit about Brooks. He's going to take it away this week, he's been so strong.

RAFA CABRERA BELLO: He's been playing unbelievable, he's won two majors this year, this is another win under his belt. He's obviously very confident, playing great golf. I can't comment more because I've been playing, I haven't seen him play, but I'm sure that he has played unbelievable.
