ADAM SCOTT (-5)



Q. A pretty decent start, mate.

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah, it was all solid stuff out there. Nice to get back to Riviera, to be honest with you. I just feel good here. Then making a couple putts on the front nine, just get in the rhythm. Yeah, a couple good up-and-downs coming in, all good solid stuff.

Q. Having that rhythm is always potentially a benefit now that you're going straight back to the tee?

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah, yeah, it would be great to get off to a good start again on the back nine. You know, you've got a chance on 10 and 11 and just keep the momentum going.

Q. Are you an advertisement for (inaudible)?

ADAM SCOTT: Yeah, I do. Look, I've talked about it a lot, I've played well here, but just has similar kind of conditions to Australia as far as you've got to drive it fairly good, you've got to hit some decent shots into the greens. It's different grasses in some places, but it's got similar design features and just feels like it plays into my wheelhouse if I hit it all right.

Q. Your experience from a perspective of how challenging is it with the weather and delays, et cetera? That's got to be something that doesn't happen every week, but it seems like it has the last few weeks.

ADAM SCOTT: Well, yeah, but I also got the rest and I think maybe luckily I took Tuesday off as well, and then I got Thursday off, so I can't really complain. I'm actually just happy the course is in very good shape still. It's not like last week got so sloppy and then, you know, kind of becomes not fun if you're not playing well, whereas it's in good shape still out here. The greens are rolling good and let's hope for no more rain.
