**Q. First group and you make birdie and you're safely through now. Do you think it was a good thing to be in the first group going out?**

**ROBERT MACINTYRE:** Yeah, I've been in a couple of playoffs last year for tournaments on the Challenge Tour and always teed off second team and I just thought, I said to Greg, my caddie, I goes, (inaudible) last off. Sure enough, pulled out number one and that was it. No, it's a great way to make it through. No, it's a good tournament. Just anyone can win it now, that's what we're here for.

**Q. How did you find Saturday as a whole? Were you sort of monitoring the 6 and the 5 and the numbers, or how did you approach it?**

**ROBERT MACINTYRE:** Yeah, I think I monitored it too much. I should have just played my game. After 14 there was a leaderboard on the back left and I seen 6 and I was 8 coming down 17 and I missed a short putt. I struggled with my putting lately. Missed a short putt on 17, and on 18 I just caught a gust. But if I didn't -- if I wasn't looking at the leaderboard I should have just cruised through, but that's golf.

**Q. Match play record, have you played much of it in the last -- how long have you been a pro now?**

**ROBERT MACINTYRE:** A year and a half.

**Q. Yeah, yeah, yeah. So obviously you would have played a fair bit of amateur --**

**ROBERT MACINTYRE:** Not much.

**Q. -- in recent history.**

**ROBERT MACINTYRE:** Got beat in the final of the British Am, so match play record's not bad as far as saying that. But 18 holes is a sprint, six holes is even quicker, so just got to go out there and attack. That's the way I play golf.

**Q. Do you think the holes set up that we'll play tomorrow well for that kind of approach to this match play because obviously it's a to'ing and fro'ing, and if the other guy makes mistakes, you can change your mindset. But do you think the holes set up well for an aggressive mindset?**

**ROBERT MACINTYRE:** Definitely. I mean, there's holes out there where you've got to be

aggressive. Obviously it's going to depend on what the other player does as well. I'm just going to go out there and play the man and hopefully we can get the job done.
