

HANNAH GREEN

Q. Hannah Green, you're going to be the leading Australian, within five or six heading into the final round, but I imagine that's still not probably positive things in your head today.

HANNAH GREEN: Yeah, today was a lot rougher. I hit a lot of wide tee shots and so I had a lot of wide shots coming into the green. So, was in a lot more bunkers than I really should have been. But, I mean, with how I was playing, I probably should be happy with 1 over. It could have been a hell of a lot worse. I did hole a lot of clutch putts when I needed to. So, yeah, 73 wasn't too bad, but then it was kind of frustrating as well.

Q. So, birdied the first. And when did you realise things weren't as you hoped they would be?

HANNAH GREEN: Well, I didn't hit a very good chip shot actually, it just trickled over the back, but it was still four metres from the pin and holed a good putt. But yeah, just hit a few shots that wasn't really -- that I hadn't really seen in a while. So, yeah, I knew that I was grinding it out when I missed a couple of greens from -- with hitting a 9-iron in. So, just little things like that. So, I'm going to go to the range, see what's going on. Hopefully, yeah, hit them better out there.

Q. So the grind pay, you're still well within reach, is that what you take away?

HANNAH GREEN: Yeah, definitely. I didn't think that I would be leading Australian. I thought some of the girls would jump right up. I haven't seen any of the leaderboards, actually, during my round. I saw who was leading, but I haven't seen anything past the top 5. So that's a nice thing to have. And hopefully I can still sleep in tomorrow.

Q. You can. Is there something specific you're going to go work on, on the range, or --

HANNAH GREEN: Yeah, I did some -- I saw Ryan Lundstedt. He lives here in Adelaide. And he works closely with Richie and myself, so we just did a little thing -- a couple little things to pick up my setup. And yeah, I will just probably see how that is looking, see if I need to control it a little bit better. But, yeah, I know things aren't too far off, so I can't be too hard on myself.
