**Q. Good day. I mean, you're in great position for tomorrow and you've gotten progressively better every day, don't you think?**

**CHARLES HOWELL III:** Yeah, today, it was a weird day. I mean, the leaders weren't really running away with it. I played with Bryson the first two days and I kind of expected him to run away today. I was fortunate with my finish, I made a long one on 17, which was a bit of a surprise, and then the three up 18. Yeah, it's a crazy game. It was a lot of patience today and we were fortunate on the finish.

**Q. There's been a ton of eagles this week and you have three alone. That's kind of helped things along, but you can make them here.**

**CHARLES HOWELL III:** You can, and the greens are still soft and receptive enough to do it. It's such a good golf course because there's enough holes out there where you've got to suck it up and hit a shot and then there's other birdie holes as well. With having very little wind, the scores are holding up. Like I said, I really expected Bryson to run today, which so I'm quite sure he has a low one in him tomorrow.

**Q. You've been out here for a long time and your win was early in the season, but now here at the end with just a few weeks left, you've got a shot, Charles. It's a roller coaster as you know, but you're peaking again, I think.**

**CHARLES HOWELL III:** It is a roller coaster and I kind of like it because it will be a shootout tomorrow, which takes a little bit of pressure off knowing that you have to go out there and make a bunch of birdies.

Yeah, in a weird way I think it makes it a little bit easier. Yeah, you're right, this game is so dang crazy, I've played it long enough to know anything can happen. I do know one thing, it will take low ones tomorrow.

**Q. Lastly, as a veteran with so much at stake, FedExCup points, Wyndham Rewards, Presidents Cup, all this stuff, do you look at that a lot? I mean, are you keeping almost a daily watch on that?**

**CHARLES HOWELL III:** You know, yes. I mean, I think especially the FedExCup because being outside the top 50 in the world ranking, if I can get in the TOUR Championship, it helps me a lot with next year getting into the big events, et cetera. So that's a big one for me. I haven't made the TOUR Championship in a long time, so that would get me back into the Masters and that's kind of what I'm looking at now.
