

ROUND 4 INTERVIEW

CARLOS ORTIZ (-17)

Q. Sixty-four matches your low final round that you had at the Sanderson Farms, so that was a while back. That's really good playing this last day.

CARLOS ORTIZ: Yeah, I've been playing great for the last two months, I just haven't been able to put it together. Last, you know, four tournaments have been able to put some good rounds together, not the four rounds, and finally was able to put them together this tournament.

Q. At 17 I thought you had a hole-in-one, at 18 I thought you had an eagle. You wind up birdie-birdie finished strong.

CARLOS ORTIZ: Yeah, I played great. I honestly didn't do anything spectacular. I actually missed a couple putts coming in, but I had that tap-in on 17 and obviously that two-putt on 18, that was great. So I'm just really pleased the way I played.

Q. You came in this week 119th in FedExCup points. This is going to be your best finish of the season regardless of what happens here the last hour and a half. How exciting is that, because you needed this week?

CARLOS ORTIZ: It's exciting because I can take some weeks off. I'm tired. I've been playing I think five to six weeks in a row and I'm playing next week obviously. I'm just happy I can take maybe a week off and get ready for the Playoffs.

Q. You are the leader at the moment in the clubhouse. What are you going to do over the next 90 minutes or so?

CARLOS ORTIZ: I'll wait. I don't think it's going to hold. There's no wind out there, it's playing easy, but I don't care. I always try to play my best, I did the best I could this week and I'm just happy with the way I played.
