

**ROUND 4 INTERVIEW**  
**October 13, 2019**



**SCOTT HARRINGTON (-13)**

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**Q. So you didn't get in a playoff, but overall it was a great week for you. How would you sum it up?**

**SCOTT HARRINGTON:** Like you said, it was a great week, yeah. I fell one short, but I got nothing to hold my head about. I hit great shots coming down the stretch. Yeah, there's a couple putts I'd like to have back, but I'm just -- it's all positives out of this week. This opens up a lot of things for me the rest of the year, that's for sure, and just for my career in general just to know that for my first time in contention that I can play on this stage under these lights and pull off the shots when I need them.

**Q. How were you spending the time just kind of waiting out to see what would happen? I saw you on the range on the phone. Was that with Jennifer?**

**SCOTT HARRINGTON:** Yeah, I talked to my wife for a second, I talked to my coach, Boyd, a little bit. Just hitting a few balls. I was kind of just listening to the rules official updating me on what was happening.

But I'm really happy for Lanto. He's a friend, he's a great dude, he's been playing awesome so far this year. Yeah, just very happy for him.

**Q. Did you guys have discussions about her coming out here?**

**SCOTT HARRINGTON:** We talked -- so after -- it's kind of a funny, story. Going into yesterday, we were kind of like if I played really well, if I played well yesterday and perhaps was maybe a little closer -- it's not like she didn't think I was going to win or anything, but we talked about it after my round yesterday and we just kind of ultimately decided for her -- she was going to have to fly out this morning and then go right back home. We just kind of decided that she was going to stay home. But it's all good, she'll be here a lot this year.

**Q. Do you get a sense when you're out there that people that know your story are rooting for her?**

**SCOTT HARRINGTON:** I do, yeah, just because I'm not a household name, I'm far from it. In general, people haven't known me for my whole career except for pretty extreme golf fans. So far just in the early part of the season the number of people who have -- fans who have, you know, put out their hand and said, hey, really pulling for you this week. They know our story and I can tell there's been a lot of instances like that. Yeah, it's really cool and it's been pretty neat, the response that we've gotten from everybody. There's people with the Tour, players who I didn't know before, big-name players the first couple events of

the year coming up and wanting to shake my hand and introduce themselves and say, hey, I'm really happy for you and all that. For them to take their time and do that is really neat. Yeah, the response has been really cool.

**Q. And also, do you feel like, especially with what you've been able to accomplish the last few months, that you didn't feel as much pressure because there's other things?**

**SCOTT HARRINGTON:** Yes, I thought about it last night, I thought about it today on the course. Pressure. Our last two years has been pressure and this is nothing, this is a game. There's no doubt that it's changed my perspective a bit.

And also, in a different regard, I felt like when I got my card in Portland at our last regular season event, that final round, I said at the time that's going to be the most pressure I'll ever play under in my career. I don't care if I'm in a final group of a major, that round was the most pressure filled round I'll ever have to play because I'm trying to achieve something that I've been working towards for so long that I had in front of me. To get over that hump and to get my card for the first time in my hometown, and there was so much going on, to be able to pull off. I went back to that round a lot today. That was big for my development and I feel like anything after that round is going to feel a little bit easy. Today I felt great. I was nervous, but it was great.

**Q. Just how excited are you about the future given all that, given your finish today?**

**SCOTT HARRINGTON:** Really excited. It's a bit surreal. It's a bit surreal still that I'm playing on the PGA TOUR, it's surreal that I'm contending to win tournaments. But with that said, I've always believed and I know that my game is at that level. But to finally kind of put that on display and to prove it to myself and anybody else, it's just, yeah, I'm very excited.
