

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

DANNY LEE (-5)

Q. If we can just get some comments about your round, 5 under today?

DANNY LEE: I started off really nice. I was driving it very well. I was covering a lot of the corner bunkers I couldn't do a couple years ago when I was here, I got a lot longer than last time I was here and I definitely took advantage out of it. Made some putts out there on the front nine, but on the back nine, I think three and four I made two bogeys in a row. I just missed a couple short ones, right-to-left line. I just didn't commit to my lines and it just slipped away from me. I birdied on seven and eight, which is a very nice bounce-back. Pleased with my round today.

Q. How are the conditions out there?

DANNY LEE: It was very, I wouldn't say like easy, easy, but the way the wind direction is going is a lot easier than any other wind direction, so it makes the golf course a lot easier. Especially like 18, if you can hit a decent drive to the left low fairway, you can get it all the way down there, so you're going to have a short iron into a par 5. You can definitely take advantage out of it.

Q. And how is it being back in Korea with all the Korean fans cheering for you?

DANNY LEE: Whenever I come over here, I feel like I don't have that many fans because I'm from New Zealand. I look Korean and speak Korean. I've got to expect that. I've just got to play well in Korean event and hopefully this might be the week to do it.
