WEBB SIMPSON (-19, lost second playoff hole)

Q. What do you take away from this week?

WEBB SIMPSON: Yeah, congrats to Tyler, he played great. To birdie the last two holes in regulation was awesome and then to birdie there on the second was great, so I'm happy for him. Just not my best drive there to give myself a birdie opportunity. Close again here.

Q. You played brilliant. Here we are again, another close call at the RSM. You've got to start thinking, what do I need to do to win this event?

WEBB SIMPSON: I know, another close call. You know, good for Tyler for making birdie on the last two holes in regulation and again there, so happy for him.

Q. You mentioned how many times you love it around here. We're heading into the holiday season to spend some time with your family. I know when the disappointment settles and you look back, this is a big performance. Considering this is only the second start, it's a big performance for you.

WEBB SIMPSON: Yeah, I only played twice this fall, so it definitely helps with the FedExCup ranking going into the new year because I had a lot of time at home. But yeah, I got Hero and Presidents Cup, so a little more golf to play this year. Yeah, I'm excited where the game is and I'll be ready come Sony.

Q. (In progress) with the conditions and everything that was on the line today?

WEBB SIMPSON: It played really tough all day. It was blowing it seemed like a solid 20 and gusts here and there, and the pins were tough. They did a good job of setup, but they didn't make it easy for us. It was especially hard starting out the way we did, so I played really well given the conditions.

Q. We talked earlier this week about wanting to be consistent, and you knew the winds would come. Is there a level of frustration or are you still pleased with your consistency?

WEBB SIMPSON: No, I'm very pleased with the way I played. Obviously I would like the drive back in the playoff to give myself a birdie chance, but hats off to Tyler birdieing the last two in regulation and again there in the playoff. Tough way to finish, but I gave it everything

I had.

WEBB SIMPSON: Just that my game is continuing to build and go in the right direction. Putting in time this fall in the gym with Paul and Butch and Pat Goss, it's been I think going in the right direction for a while and looking forward to playing again soon at the Sony.
