Q. What sort of things were working the best in your game going around to put this score on the board?

And the greens, the speeds of the greens this week were a speed where you could make a lot of putts. They never got terribly fast or slow, it's right in that middle ground where you could really putt quite aggressively. But yeah, the scores that the guys are shooting out there, it lends itself to you better keep being aggressive.

Q. Based on what you've done so far this season, what does a result like this do for you?

CHARLES HOWELL III: Well, it's nice. I mean, frankly, it's just been weird since we've come back from this thing. I know the whole world wants to get back to normal or as close as we can to normal.
