HARRIS ENGLISH: I grew up in Georgia so I'm very comfortable with this layout. the course is in great shape right now and I felt like I played pretty solid.

Q. You're inside the top-30 in the FedEx coming into this week playing out of the category you're playing out of this year, how satisfied are you with the way the year's gone knowing you were going to get starts here and there?

HARRIS ENGLISH: Yeah, I'm very satisfied with how the year's going. I knew coming into it that I wasn't going to get as many starts as I would like, but coming up with a game plan that I was going to be 100 percent ready for every start and well rested and ready to play. I felt like my game's been really well. I think I've maybe missed two cuts this year. Just playing really solid and then getting up in the top-10 a lot and up near the top of the leaderboard where I feel like I'm capable of playing and it's been a lot of fun. I feel like I've put a lot of work in with my team back home in Sea Island and the work has definitely paid off.

Q. What's been the biggest improvement over the last couple years in your game?

HARRIS ENGLISH: Definitely tee to green. I feel like when I'm on, I'm one of the best iron players on Tour and I feel like it's really come back this year. Really, greens in regulation number has jumped way up. I know the past couple years it was maybe not even the top-100 and I think I'm probably top-10 this year, so that's been a huge stat because I feel like I'm a good putter week to week, pretty consistent. So the more greens I hit, the better chance I'm going to have.

Q. You feel comfortable here at Sedgefield on these greens and on this course, and obviously going forward these next three weeks in the Playoffs. What do you feel like is what you have to do to kind of make that run, maybe get a win that's been so close this year and maybe make that run deep into the Playoffs?

HARRIS ENGLISH: Yeah, it's been close. I feel like the more and more I get in contention, the easier it's going to become, the more used to it I'm going to become. I feel like my game's in a good spot, it's just making that putt here or there, hitting that clutch shot here or there. I know it's close and I know it's right around the corner and I'm going to keep giving myself the best chance every week. I like TPC Boston next week and I like Olympia Fields after, so I feel like I'm going to give it a run and see if I can climb up that FedExCup.

Q. Are you starting to feel some of those – the old feels that you had when you won a couple times on Tour, when you were right there in contention a lot?

HARRIS ENGLISH: Yeah, yeah, I mean, making seven birdies today, I feel like my birdie average has been way up there and feel like my game's in good shape. It's probably been the best this year or even the past couple weeks as it's been in a long, long time and it feels good. Feel like I got a good system working right now and I'm going to stick to it.
