BROOKS KOEPKA (-2)

Q. How did it feel to be back out there competing again?

BROOKS KOEPKA: Just nice to be back playing. It feels good. I've actually played pretty solid. I was happy with it. I am mean, I don't want to complain about bad breaks, I don't normally do that, but I feel I was a foot, yard here, yard there from being really good and just kind of got unlucky.

Q. Seemed like early on, really hitting the ball well, just the putts maybe weren't -- maybe the judging the speed a little --

BROOKS KOEPKA: I hit it solid. I had maybe two bad swings, 9 tee and then the one I hit in the water on the back, was it 14? Those are the only two bad swings I made all day. I hit good putts, they just didn't go in. You know, 18, left a couple of them right short in the jaw. Yeah, I don't know, I thought I played a hell of a lot better than the score.

Q. Everything feel good?

BROOKS KOEPKA: Yeah, everything feels good, I feel great.

Q. What were you happiest with out there today and what would you might have been more disappointed with?

BROOKS KOEPKA: Disappointed with like the scoring. I played way better. Like I said, a yard here, a yard there and it's 18, if it's a yard, 16 if it's a yard left it's on the green. Just felt like I got quite a few bad breaks, but it happens, it's golf.

Q. What were you happiest with?

BROOKS KOEPKA: I mean, I hit it solid, I putted pretty well, I hit everything online that I wanted to and just made some -- I guess one sloppy mistake there, the three-putt.

Q. So you won't be hitting the tables tonight with the bad breaks you got?

BROOKS KOEPKA: No, I wouldn't.

Q. I'm only kidding.

BROOKS KOEPKA: I'm good, I'm good.

Q. One last one, from the other times you've come back from injuries, did anything feel different or similar just the way the body felt or way the game felt?

BROOKS KOEPKA: I feel normal now, I just feel like I'm supposed to. So just getting a little -- this is more for just getting competitive reps for Augusta, that's kind of what this is.
