

Q. Can you walk through the two eagles, 7 and 16?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Sure. Yeah, on 7 I hit a good drive just right of the rocks. Had around 164 to the pin, a little help from the left, and me and my caddie were just talking it had to be a really good 9, there was no way an 8 could stop there. So I just focused on making the best swing I could and I started four yards left, started cutting nicely towards the pin, and once you see the guys throw the touchdown sign, it's good.

Q. Is that the COVID sign now?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Well, maybe.

And 16, I took my time off the tee because I really wanted to hit driver because it was one of those days that everything was kind of happening. Then I hit 3-iron, and when I was walking up to the ball, it's like, okay, we're closer than I thought we were. Had 278 pin, I think, so it was like a nice 3-wood could get there. My caddie was like, yeah, man, whatever you're feeling like, I'm with you. So I was aiming a little left and tried to cut it. It didn't cut much, hit the tree and it came right backwards. Like we thought it was maybe going to be wet, but happily it was short of the water.

Then 50-yarder and my caddie was like, be aggressive, you already took a risk on shot No. 2, so might as well just keep going. So I was like, all right, sure. So I throw it up there and find the hole. So it was pretty sweet.

Q. Have you ever had an eventful round like this with the birdies and bogeys and everything?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

Q. What do your emotions do when you're up and down like that?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: I just get out of the way. At first I was like what should I do, should I be more calm, should I attack more? I just stopped trying to play anything and just keep playing golf. It's just one of those days it happens.

Q. What do you make of this place? You've never been here before I take it?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: It's awesome, it's beautiful. I like a lot of elevation changes, you can make a lot of birdies. All par 5s are reachable. Five par 5s actually. fun par 3s. It's a great

place, I like it. There's a lot of movement, anything can happen.

Q. Did you lose a ball on 14 in the tree?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: No, I didn't lose it, I found it up there like against the shrub and had to take a 6 on that hole.

Q. Had you hit a provisional off the tee?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: I did hit a provisional.

Q. Okay. So whenever you could have dropped an unplayable, you were better off with the provisional?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Yeah. My caddie, he told me, yeah, those two clubs aren't getting you anywhere. And I couldn't play that ball that was there because I already found my ball. I would have to go back to the tee and hit an unplayable, like I re-tee. I was like, no, I think I can just kind of take it out. I ended up laying up 150 yards, but it ended up in divot. It just happens, like a weird day.

Q. Was there any comparison between this week and last week? I know you finished top-10 there. Any comparisons with the golf course and as far as your game?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: I don't know. Yeah, last week was a fun course as well for me. Like you have to hit like different things off the tee, you have to curve the ball a little bit here and there. It's a fun, entertaining course and I like them that way when you get a lot of birdie chances and you can go low.

Q. And one last one, it's a little bit different here on the front compared with last week, but did you find last week more flat, lack of energy just because you couldn't see anyone else on the golf course while you were playing, different from, say --

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Yeah.

Q. -- different from Hilton Head?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Yeah, yeah, I get it.

Q. Were you bored?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: No, I wasn't bored. No, last week was great, the place is awesome. I just didn't get hot ever. I played really solid golf, but I just never rallied three or four birdies in a row or made an eagle, so last week was a little flat. This week, I don't know, it kept happening. The guys cheered for me and I was like, let's go.

Q. Was this a normal round for you?

SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ: Not a normal round.

Q. Hope not.
