TONY FINAU (-1)

Q. Tony, great playing today. If we can just get an opening comment on the round.

TONY FINAU: Yeah, thanks. First of all, I think my thoughts on the golf course, it's a tricky golf course, no question. It's got length, you've got to hit it in the fairway here to score and I actually scored it quite nice. I don't feel like I hit it great, but was able to get up and down when I needed to and still turn in an under-par round.

Q. Any particular holes stand out in terms of difficulty or holes you might have liked?

TONY FINAU: I mean, the par 3s are great. I think the par 3s are great. No. 9 is a great hole. On the back nine I'm a huge fan of No. 15. I think it's 112 yards today and it's probably going to average over par just the way the green is. It's like a mountain, you either hit it on the green or it's going to be really hard to get up and down. Just those two par 3s I think are amazing holes. I think it kind of speaks to you don't have to have a 240-yard hole to make it good.

Q. And just lastly, with the fans being here domestically for the first time at a PGA TOUR event since March, what's it like to have a little bit more energy out here and what was your reaction to having the fans out here?

TONY FINAU: Yeah, well, right out of the gate when they said my name on the first tee, it was cool to have some people kind of cheer. It's been a while since I've heard that. It feels nice to have some of our fans back and just look forward to having all of them back in bunches.
