**Q. You talked about coming into the week and seeing where you were. Great opening round. What do you take away from today?**

**ADAM SCOTT:** Yeah, well, I liked where I was in practice and it kind of panned out for me today. I got off to a bad start and I didn't panic and hung in there and hit lots of good shots, made a couple putts. You know, I can see this week is going to be one of those long weeks on the golf course, it's a pretty relentless golf course. It demands a lot of good hitting. And then the greens are beautiful, but they're tricky to putt on, so it's going to be a grind this week. But I like where everything is so far. If I can see a little bit of improvement in the next three days, I might have a chance here this week and I'll feel good about going to next week.

**Q. Some guys did have trouble on the back, but you had a flawless back nine. Can you just talk about that last stretch?**

**ADAM SCOTT:** Yeah, I played a really good nine holes. I really put it together. Most of the nine I was in good position. I actually hit a -- left one out there because I didn't birdie the par 5 12th from a good position in the fairway, but everything else was really good. I took advantage of a few. It's what I needed after a tough start.

**Q. And last question, first event in the United States to welcome back fans. What was it like having fans out there? Were you comfortable --**

**ADAM SCOTT:** Oh, yeah.

**Q. Was it nice energy?**

**ADAM SCOTT:** It was great, it was good. It was fun to have a bit of volume out on the golf course again. I think also fun for them. They've obviously missed being able to come out to the PGA TOUR, and I was playing with the world No. 1 today so we had a great group and everyone excited to see him. Nice to have a bit of an atmosphere again. Thankful they're allowed out here this week.
