HAROLD VARNER III (-3)

Q. Just an overall assessment. Is this the first time you've played Memorial Park, this week?

HAROLD VARNER III: Yeah, first time. Obviously it's hard, so I was pretty excited about that playing the practice round. But everyone's got to play it, so it's just a great opportunity. Again, I know last week wasn't my best week, so it's just a good time to put that behind me.

Q. What particularly is working well for you and that's fitting well with this trickier golf course?

HAROLD VARNER III: Just driving it well, hitting a lot of greens. It's really hard to hit the greens and I think I hit a good number of them. Just being patient. Obviously the scores aren't going to be low, so you've just got to hang around there.

Q. Can you talk about Nos. 5 through 8 and what was rolling there for you?

HAROLD VARNER III: Nos. 5 through 8, I was doing the same thing I was doing all day, just give myself looks and capitalize obviously on those holes. I thought it was three birdies in a row, but then I signed my scorecard and obviously it was a few more. I'll take them whenever they come.

Q. Lastly, can you talk about this is the first domestic PGA TOUR event with fans back on site, what's it like to play in front of these limited crowds?

HAROLD VARNER III: Obviously the crowds are, you know, awesome. It's why we -- I like showing off, I like performing, so it's good for me. I don't focus as much, but it is what it is, it's a part of it. I think people need people right now, it's an important thing. So it's just good to see obviously a lot of masks, but inside I know they're smiling, excited to be out here.
