**Q. Dustin, good playing today. If we could just get an opening comment on the round.**

**DUSTIN JOHNSON:** Yeah, obviously it was very solid today. I felt like -- I felt like I played pretty well yesterday, just a little rusty. It was my first event since the U.S. Open, so just a little rusty, but felt like I swung it pretty well, just hit a couple bad iron shots. But I think that was more just from not trusting what I was doing, just from not being out there. But today did a lot better, hit a lot of really nice iron shots and felt like I managed my game very well, drove it well, hit a lot of quality shots, so very pleased with how I played today.

**Q. Impressions of the golf course after two rounds?**

**DUSTIN JOHNSON:** Yeah, I think the rules officials have done a really good job with the setup because it could get away from you a little bit just because it's so severe around the greens. Yeah, I think they've done a great job. So I think the course is playing -- it's still a tough golf course and you've got to hit very quality golf shots if you want to shoot a good number, but so far I'm very pleased with how they set it up.

**Q. Just lastly, your goals going into the weekend?**

**DUSTIN JOHNSON:** Yeah, I just want to keep -- I just need the reps before next week. Yeah, I'm pleased with where I'm at. Obviously anything under par I think is going to be -- if I can go out and shoot a good score tomorrow I'm going to have a chance come Sunday. Obviously I'm just looking to get a little better each day and yeah. I'm happy where I'm at.
