



Q. Tell us about your round today.

PAUL GOYDOS: It was a nice day. I kind of got off to I wouldn't say a slow start. But maybe not the most confident start. I hit a sprinkler head or something on 3 and it caught a good break and it kicked somewhere I could get up and down, and hit a poor shot. Then I chipped in on 4 for birdie, which kind of got the thing started. Played 5 nicely, played 7 nicely, 8 nicely.

Now things are going in the right direction. The back nine starts out 10, 11, 12, 13 are not the easiest holes, pars are good there. I hit a good shot on 13 and made a birdie from a foot. Then I really got comfortable and I hit good shots the rest of the way. I hit a good shot on 16 and made a 10-footer there. I hit two good shots on 18 right in front of the green, chipped it up. As the day went on, it got better and better and better.

Q. Do you feel like your game is sort of trending here towards the end of the year?

PAUL GOYDOS: I don't think I've ever been able to say that about my game, it's always more of a jack-in-the-box, just keep grinding and hope the game pops up. But I've had some success here. I haven't won here, I really haven't had a good finish here, but I've had good rounds and been near the lead early in the tournament. Obviously I did well at Desert Mountain, too. Just keep playing and see what happens.

Q. How's the course playing this week?

PAUL GOYDOS: So far, great. The greens are embarrassingly good. If you miss a putt, you either misread or mis-hit it, there's no way it's not going to roll on the line that you hit it on. It might be the best Bermuda greens I've ever seen in my life. Today there was an absolute absence of conditions, there was no wind, no sun. I can't imagine you could have a better day for scoring than you had today.

Q. Did you know that your caddie, it's his birthday today?

PAUL GOYDOS: Yes.

Q. And your scoring average is 64 --

PAUL GOYDOS: Yeah, I've shot 64 on both his birthdays, the last round at Richmond a few years back and today. That's not bad.
